Multiply Whole Numbers by 1000 Game

Play It 1

You need:

0 - 9 Dice

0 - 100,000 blank number line

To play:

Players take it in turns to roll the dice twice to create a 2-digit number.

Multiply your number by 1000

Plot your answer on a 0 - 100,000 blank number line, convincing your partner that you are plotting it in the correct place.

To win:

The winner is the first player to plot four points without any of their opponent's points in between.



Calculate:

Do It 2

$$4.7 \times 10 = \boxed{47} \quad 0.47 \times 10 = \boxed{4.7} \quad 10 \times 12.04 = \boxed{120.4}$$

$$2.3 \times 10 = \boxed{23} \quad 0.05 \times 10 = \boxed{0.5} \quad 50.01 \times 10 = \boxed{500.1}$$

$$12.3 \times 10 = \boxed{123} \quad 1.03 \times 10 = \boxed{10.3} \quad 10 \times 0.007 = \boxed{0.07}$$
